JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

Now on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1981,  
comes on for hearing the above matter. Plaintiff, State of  
Kansas, appears by Linda P. Jeffrey, Assistant Attorney General,  
and defendant, Glen Bishop, appears by his attorney, Randall  
C. Henry. The plaintiff, having filed its petition herein on  
the 10th day of December, 1980, and the defendant having been  
duly served with summons and petition as prescribed by law, have  
each of them stipulated and consented to the Entry of Judgment  
without a trial or adjudication of any issue of fact or law herein.  
The parties agree and stipulate to the orders hereinafter set  
forth.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties hereto.
2. That defendant is enjoined from violating the Kansas Consumer Protection Act, specifically by entering into a contract to perform home repairs and household improvements and in connection therewith taking money and payment, but failing and refusing to make reasonable efforts to comply with the contract.


3. That defendant is enjoined from entering into contracts to perform home repairs and household improvements without complying fully with K.S.A. 50-640. Defendant shall inform the consumer orally of his or her right to cancel and shall furnish the consumer with written notice of his or her right to cancel.

4. That defendant will provide the Attorney General with a complete list of those Kansas consumers with whom defendant has agreed to perform repair work and accepted prepayment, full or partial, on or before the date of entry of this Judgment. Plaintiff will contact these consumers and ascertain whether a refund is desired as opposed to specific performance. If a refund is desired, defendant shall pay that amount to the Office of the Attorney General for distribution thirty days after receipt by defendant of notice of individuals requesting refunds and the corresponding amount. The Attorney General will send said notice to defendant within thirty days of entry of this judgment. In those instances where specific performance is requested, the plaintiff and defendant shall review each situation individually and arrive at a time for completion which is reasonable and mutually agreed to. Failure of defendant to comply with this judgment shall render defendant liable for penalties as provided by law.

5. That defendant will pay \$500 to the Attorney General Court Cost Fund on or before entry of this judgment.

6. That defendant will pay \$2,000 to the General Fund of the State of Kansas.


7. That defendant will pay the costs of this action.


